IMYC	<p>Thematic Unit: Relationship Big Idea: Every individual thing is affected by other things.</p> <p>Science: Students will take a look at how photosynthetic organisms underpin all life on our planet, and their survival is reliant upon their sophisticated interactions with the sun, the earth, the atmosphere, and other organisms. Then they will explore other symbiotic relationships in the natural world.</p> <p>Geography: In this unit, students will explore the way in which the Earth's tectonic plates are moved according to natural processes. They will look at how the movements of the plates affect the formation of the landscape, but also how these movements can be the cause of natural disasters.</p> <p>History: Students will study the assassination of Archduke Franz Ferdinand, the chain of events that led to his death, and the chain of events that followed. They will consider the extent to which the First World War was inevitable given the nature of European diplomatic relationships in 1914 and connect how these events are still relevant in today's world.</p> <p>ICT: Students will look at spreadsheets and different functions of data handling software that allow users to input data so that it can remain independent, as well as allowing them to input data so that it can become interdependent on other data.</p>
